Update on completion of downtown sidewalks and handrails, Project update by Tom Klimek, Project is completed only minor repairs need to be completed. Primer was not completely dry on handrails so they need to be repainted once the weather is warm enough. Kitt inquired, about the space in front of the Post Office, as curbing is now six inches high to see if anything can be done to make sure people see the drop off. Mr. Klimek suggested that that curbs and drops be painted. Mr. Pauken stated that most people in Bisbee are happy with the work done on the sidewalks.

Mr. Pauken also told the committee that the intersections of Main Street needed to be completely redesigned by Public works and the staff did and excellent job making the

project work. John Harwood commended Mr. Pauken for taking the initiative to get the work done.

Discussion of Priority Project of Crossing safety for Highway 92 and Naco Highway, John was hoping to have a video about how dangerous crossing is at this intersection especially if impaired, he will continue to work on it. Work had been done on this intersection in the past with ADOT. Mr. Pauken asked that the record reflect that the City of Bisbee has done previous work on this crossing. That information should be in Community Development files, and that the City of Bisbee City agrees with the Disabilities committees recommendations 100%. Mr. Pauken informed the committee that this intersection is not under the jurisdiction of the City but of ADOT. We do not know why work has not gone forward. It is believed that this is due to budget cuts. Mr. Pauken is happy to assist Committee with talking to local representatives to bring this intersection repair back into the loop. Mr. Pauken's office will work with Community Development to write letter in support of moving project forward.

Motion made by Tyce and seconded by Kitt to write a letters to local officials, Governor's office and ADOT in support of moving forward on project on Highway 92 and Naco Highway. Motion passes unanimously passes.
