City of Bisbee Public Hearing Regarding Use of CDBG Funds

The City of Bisbee is intending to apply for up to 2.4 million dollars in federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Colonia set aside funds from the Arizona Department of Housing. Colonia CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight, or address urgent need within a designated Colonia neighborhood. In Bisbee, those neighborhoods are Bakerville and Tin Town only.

Two public hearings will be held to gather citizen input on the use of these CDBG funds. The public hearings will be held following dates and times:
